## Poo bags

Owning a dog brings much pleasure but carries with it many responsibilities.

Cleaning up after your dog is one of the key areas of responsibilities, especially in public places. You can face considerable fines if you do not clear up (Dog Fouling of the Land Act 1996)

Carry poo bags with you at all times.

## Dog Identification Tags

Hundreds of dogs go missing every year and are not reunited with their owners because they have no form of identification. For peace of mind it is essential they are properly identified so that if lost, when found, they can be returned to their relieved owner as quickly as possible.

The Control of Dogs Order 1992 mandates that any dog in a highway or public place must wear a collar or id tag with the **owner's name, address** (postcode and house number) **engraved** on it. Your telephone number is optional (but advisable).

You can be fined up to £5000 if your dog does not carry a correct identification tag.

## Lead and Collar

A lead, suitable for your dog, and a collar (or check chain / half checks collar). We sell a range of leather leads and chains at class. We do not allow the use of retractable leads during training.

## Toy (non-squeaky) /Training Treats

To assist you with your dog training! We do sell a range of Barker & Barker liver training treats at class.

## Dog Blanket or Bed

Dogs need to sit next to your chair, in-between exercises, and the use of a dog blanket or bed will help to settle your pet, and aid future training.
